

**TERMS AND CONDITIONS ON THE JOINT WEBSITE
ON AVAILABILITY OF RISK MITIGATION INSTRUMENTS FOR PRIVATE
INFRASTRUCTURE INVESTMENT IN ASEAN MEMBER STATES**
